For mutual coexistence. Let us pray that societies where coexistence seems more difficult might not succumb to the temptation of confrontation for ethnic, political, religious or ideological reasons.

TWENTY FIRST SUNDAY OF ORDINARY TIME, YEAR C:

This Sunday, the church reminds us of the reunion of all God's people at the feast of His Kingdom. It is not only Jews and Christians that the Lord will gather unto himself. He will also gather people from all nations, all those willing to submit to his loving care. The readings of this Sunday, especially the first and the Gospel, are closely related. Both bare a powerful message of hope. That is the reunion and restoration of the people of God. The first reading is a prophecy about the return of God's People to Jerusalem. It is an assurance that God will fulfil his promises to us. Here, the prophet makes three essential points. The first is that God will soon fulfil his promise of restoring us to himself. He will surely do this to show his saving power. The second is the fact that God has a purpose for this gathering. This is the glory of his name. In other words, every work he does have the remote aim of giving glory to him. Third, in addition to gathering us unto Himself, God will also make us his ambassadors to other nations. The second reading from Hebrews reminds us that obedience and discipline will help us respond and effectively return to the Lord. In today's Gospel, Jesus answers a challenging and tricky question: Sir, will there be a few saved? He replies, "Try your best to enter by the narrow door!" So, rather than occupy oneself with arguments about the number of those to be saved, it is better to work hard for one's salvation.

Sacramental Preparation Programme at St Mary's Cathedral for Reconciliation and First Holy Communion 2025/26

Open to children of families who are registered as members of St Mary's Cathedral Parish and who regularly attend Mass at the Cathedral or Coedpoeth. Children must be baptised Catholics and be in School Year 3 as a minimum. Parents will need to provide proof of Baptism. Registration for the programme will take place at a meeting for parents in late September - date to be advised. Children/Families will need to commit to attending a regular series of preparation meetings which will be on Saturday every two weeks from October 2025 to June 2026. The dates of meetings are still being finalised but will be made available through newsletter and website by the middle of September. Children must collect a Passport which they must bring to each Mass to record attendance. Passports will be available after each Sunday Mass over the next few weeks
