27th Sunday in Ordinary Time:, Year C:

'Fan into flame the gift of God'

This Sunday, our readings lead us to consider the gift of faith, to ponder our trust in a faithful God, and to ask for the strength to offer humble service.

The prophet Habakkuk complains loudly to God that he (God) does not help in the face of tyranny and oppression. The Lord's reply is to wait faithfully, for justice will come. And as the psalmist encourages us to listen to the Lord, to be open to God at all times.

The Second Reading we continue with the letter of St Paul to Timothy which urges us all never to be ashamed of witnessing to the Lord. We has been given the gift of the Spirit, which we must continually proclaim and to rely on God's power in times of trial.

The disciples, in the Gospel, ask the Lord, 'Increase our faith'. Jesus responds with the parable of the mustard seed, and then follows on with another about the need for service of others. A life of faith is one that liberates us to follow the voice of the Spirit. The gift of faith in Christ is "not a spirit of timidity and anxiousness about the future. It is 'rather a spirit of power and of love and of self-discipline.'

Increase our faith", O Lord, teach us to use the precious gifts you gave us to serve you by being courageously at the service of all who are in need.

Please keep Fr Nicholas, his father and his family and friends in your prayers.

The start can be reached by bus, Llangollen or Oswestry or cars can be parked at Aldi Ruabon & retrieved at your leisure.

A leader & back up will be available for your assistance and a risk assessment will be in the parish office. Walkers/pilgrims are responsible for their own well being.

We aim to reach the Cathedral at approx. 14.45.
