The Pope's Intention:

For priests in crisis. Let us pray for priests going through moments of crisis in their vocation, that they may find the accompaniment they need and that communities may support them with understanding and prayer.

THIRD SUNDAY OF EASTER, YEAR A

On this third Sunday of Easter, we are invited to reflect on the joy of recognizing the Risen Christ in our lives. It reminds us that Jesus is alive and walks with us. The readings show how His followers came to believe in the resurrection. They also call us to live with hope and trust in His promise. In the first reading, Peter tells the crowd that Jesus' death and resurrection were part of God's plan. He speaks with courage, showing that the Holy Spirit gives strength to share the Good News. The Gospel tells the story of the road to Emmaus. Two disciples walk with a stranger who explains the Scriptures to them. They finally recognize Him when He breaks bread. This moment shows how Jesus is present with us in Word and Sacrament. This Sunday encourages us to look for Jesus in our daily lives. He is with us in prayer, in the Eucharist, and in the people we meet. When we open our hearts to Him, our faith grows stronger. Like the disciples on the road to Emmaus, we too can feel lost and disheartened. But when we open our hearts to Jesus, listen to His words, and invite Him into our lives, we will find joy and hope renewed. – Pope Francis.
