SIXTH SUNDAY OF EASTER, YEAR A'

A child who loses its parents early in life becomes an orphan, and life for him/her is hard.

Today there are orphanages that cater to the needs of abandoned children. When Jesus says that He will not leave His disciples as orphans, similar thoughts come to our minds. Jesus considers His disciples as members of His family, and without Him, they cannot advance in life. Today is the sixth Sunday of Easter. As we approach the feast of Pentecost, the Church invites us to celebrate the coming of



the Advocate. She calls us to celebrate the Spirit of Truth, which strengthens us in the proclamation of Good News. The message we bear is not false. Instead, it comes from the Advocate. The readings for this Sunday are taken from the final days of Jesus' earthly sojourn as well as the first steps of the infant Church after the death, resurrection and ascension of the Lord. The words of Jesus in the Gospel are from the Last Supper Discourse, just after the Lord had washed the feet of his disciples. In the Gospel we hear further exhortations from Jesus. He declared, "If you love me, you will keep my commandments." Love for Christ is not just a feeling or a set of words; it is a lived reality. It is shown in the way we act, in the choices we make, and in the way we treat others. Obedience here is not about fear but about relationship. When we truly love someone, we naturally want to please them and align our lives with their values.

For Jesus, His "Commandments" are summed up in love of God and love
