SEVENTH SUNDAY OF EASTER, YEAR A

The seventh Sunday of Easter focuses on prayer, unity, and hope as the Church awaits the coming of the Holy Spirit. It occurs between the Ascension of Jesus and Pentecost, marking the final Sunday of the Easter season before the descent of the Holy Spirit. This day invites us the faithful to

reflect on waiting for God's promises, emphasizing patience, prayer, and communal unity. In the first reading, after Jesus' ascension, the apostles return to Jerusalem and gather in an upper room with Mary and other followers, devoting themselves to prayer while awaiting the Holy Spirit. The Psalm expresses trust in

God's protection and a desire to dwell in His presence, calling for mercy and guidance. The second reading encourages believers to rejoice in sharing Christ's sufferings, promising joy and blessing through God's Spirit. In the Gospel Jesus prays for His disciples, asking the Father to keep them safe, united, and glorified, highlighting the importance of spiritual unity and faithfulness. This Sunday emphasizes prayer and vigilance; unity in faith; and hope and trust. This Sunday invites us to remain



faithful, united, and prayerful as the Church anticipates the coming of the Holy Spirit.

It is a time to reflect on personal faith, communal bonds, and the mission of living as Easter people.
