THE BODY AND BLOOD OF CHRIST – Year A, Solemnity

Today, the Church invites us to pause, to wonder, and to rejoice in the mystery that God Himself comes to us in the form of bread and wine – His Body and Blood – so that we may have life. The feast of the Body and Blood of Christ reminds us of the greatest gift of Jesus: the gift of Himself. It reminds us to recognize the True Presence - the Body and Blood, Soul and Divinity of Christ. It is the greatest treasure that we have as the Church and as individual believers, preserved in the Tabernacle and received as Holy Communion.



The purpose of this special feast are: The remembrance of Jesus who sacrificed Himself for the salvation of humanity, the institution of the Holy Eucharist/the command to celebrate this and, prominently, the belief in the real

presence of Jesus in the Blessed Eucharist. In the Gospel Jesus says: **“I am the living bread that came down from heaven; whoever eats this bread will live forever; and the bread that I will give is my flesh for the life of the world.”** This is not symbolic language. Jesus is not speaking in metaphor. He is revealing the astonishing truth: in the Eucharist, we receive not a sign of His love, but **Love**

Himself. In the Old Testament, God fed His people with manna in the desert – bread from heaven that sustained them physically. In the New Testament, He gives us the true Bread from Heaven - His very self – to sustain us spiritually and lead us to eternal life. Today, as we celebrate the Solemnity of the Body and Blood of Christ, let us remember: The Eucharist is God’s greatest gift to His Church. It is the living presence of Jesus among us. It is the food that leads to eternal life.
